Re: Nomination of Wayne Giesy for SAF honorary membership

This letter recommends Wayne Giesy for honorary membership in the Society of American Foresters. He has been an effective spokesman for the forest products industry and for the benefits of active forest management on private and public lands for several decades.

He frequently attends AFRC meetings and also comes to my office to provide me with information about forestry issues. I consider him an advisor on policy matters. It is always a pleasure to meet him and to be reminded of the importance of forestry to the life of the State of Oregon. For this reason, his voice for forestry is welcome wherever he goes.
