STATION DESCRIPTION

DESCRIBED BY COAST AND GEODETIC SURVEY 1953 (CTH)
THE STATION IS ABOUT 13 MILES NORTH OF TILLER, 6 MILES WEST OF
THE SOUTH UMPQUA GUARD STATION, 43 FEET SOUTH OF THE REMAINS OF A
LOOKOUT TOWER, AND ON THE SOUTHERN SLOPE OF A TIMBERED HILL.

TO REACH THE STATION FROM THE POST OFFICE IN TILLER. GO EAST ON
PC0862 THE MAIN ROAD FOR 13.1 MILES TO A SIDE ROAD RIGHT
ACROSS A RIVER. TAKE THE LEFT ROAD FOR 0.2 MILE TO TWO CABINS
ON THE LEFT AND THE END OF TRUCK TRAVEL. FROM HERE FOLLOW TRAIL
WEST FOR ABOUT 1 HOUR TO THE TOP OF A RIDGE AND A TRAIL FORK.
TAKE THE RIGHT FORK AND CONTINUE UP HILL FOR ABOUT 1/2 HOUR TO THE

STATION.
