## CANNIBAL MOUNTAIN

Siuslaw National Forest 14S-10W-15



May 1, 1934: "In the Waldport district a tower will be erected on Cannibal mountain." (The Eugene Register-Guard)

May 3, 1934: "New lookout houses and towers will be built in the Siuslaw national forest this summer, it is announced by R.S. Shelley, supervisor.

In the Waldport district a tower will be built on Grass mountain and one on Cannibal mountain, both in the vicinity of the Alsea river." (Morning Oregonian)

**September 6, 1934:** "Ira Jones, construction superintendent in the Siuslaw national forest, left Thursday for Cannibal mountain to look after some road work being carried on by a CCC crew." (The Eugene Register-Guard)

**September 19, 1934:** "Ira E. Jones of the Siuslaw forest headquarters here left Wednesday for the Fall Creek side camp of the Mapleton 3-C camp, where he will be the rest of the week. He will inspect construction of the lookout towers being erected on Cannibal mountain and Goodwin peak." **(The Eugene Register-Guard)** 

.....

1934: A lookout tower was constructed. (Six Twenty-Six)

1936: A garage and outhouse were built.



September 18, 1936: Panorama photos taken.



Activated: March 12, 1942. Eugene Filter Center.


1948: A tower and cab built. Howard Ash, Carpenter.

**1973:** The final year the tower was staffed. This was the last staffed lookout on the Forest.



1975: The tower was sold for salvage and removed. The cab was converted into a chicken house by the buyer.

2001: The fire-finder was auctioned on ebay in December. The winning bid was \$2000.00.
