## BACHELOR MOUNTAIN

Willamette National Forest  
11S-6E-12



**July 13, 1925:** "Ben Clausen was hit in the eye with a limb which caused some pain and threatens serious consequences, on Bachelor mountain in the center of the forest." (Albany Democrat-Herald)

**April 22, 1931:** "Practically 100 per cent visibility over the forests of the Santiam district will be made possible by the emergency lookout stations which will be added to the forest patrol service this year, according to C. C. Hall, forest supervisor.

Bachelor Mountain will be one of the eleven new emergency stations. This post will be connected with the telephone system next year." (**Statesman Journal**)

**1934:** A 14x14 L-4 ground cabin was constructed.

**1967:** The lookout was disposed of by burning and remains thrown into the toilet pit.

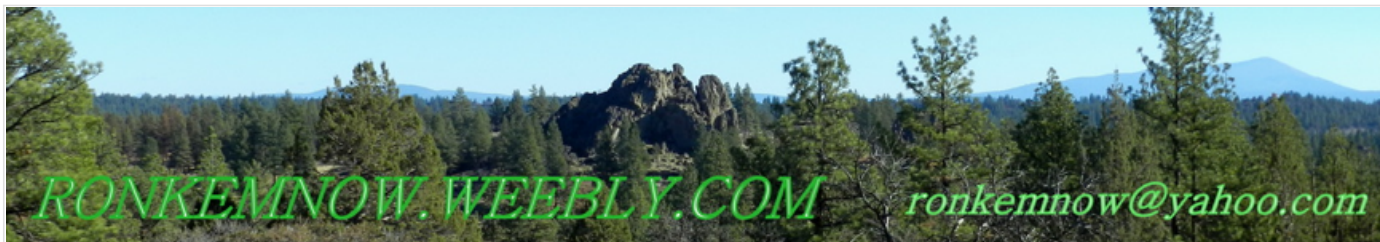
### STATION DESCRIPTION

DESCRIBED BY US GEOLOGICAL SURVEY 1955  
 LOCATED ABOUT 10 MI SW. OF DETROIT, 3.5 MI WNW. OF MARION FORKS  
 GUARD STATION, 1.5 MI ENE. OF COFFIN MTN. ON HIGHEST POINT OF  
 BACHELOR MTN.

TO REACH FROM IDANHA POST OFFICE, DRIVE 11.1 MI E. ON STATE HWY. 22 TO MARION FORKS, CONTINUE ON HWY. 1.4 MI TO RD. FORKS AND SIGN BUGABOO ROAD. TAKE RIGHT FORK LEAVING HWY. AND CROSSING BRIDGE 0.2 MI TO RD. FORKS. TAKE RIGHT FORK 3.2 MI ON MAIN RD. TO SIGN BACHELOR MTN. TRAIL RIGHT. FOLLOW TRAIL ABOUT 3 MI TO TRAIL FORKS NEAR SADDLE SW. OF BACHELOR MTN. TAKE TRAIL BEARING NE. ABOUT 1 MI TO LO AND STATION. A 3-HOUR PACK.
