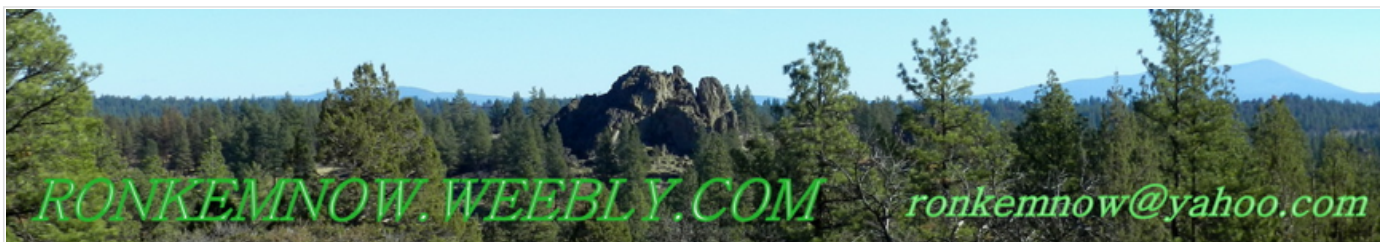

5.5 MI SW. OF COFFIN MTN. 25 FT. S. OF USFS LOH ON TOP OF SCAR
MTN.

TO REACH FROM IDANHA POST OFFICE, DRIVE 14 MI E. ON STATE HWY. 22
TO SIGN STRAIGHT CREEK. TURN RIGHT OFF HWY. 1.3 MI. TAKE LEFT
FORK 2.7 MI. TAKE LEFT FORK 2.6 MI TO POINT WHERE RD. LEAVES
CLEARING. HIKE W. ALONG EDGE OF CLEARING ABOUT 300 FT. TO TRAIL.
FOLLOW TRAIL SOUTHWESTERLY ABOUT 0.5 MI TO TRAIL FORKS. TAKE
RIGHT FORK ABOUT 2 MI TO TRAIL FORKS. TAKE LEFT FORK AS PER SIGN
SCAR MTN. LO ABOUT 0.5 MI TO TOP OF MTN., LO AND STATION. A
2-1/2-HOUR PACK.
